



Compliance Statement

PPWR / EU 2025/40, Food Contact & Chemical Safety

Legal Classification pursuant to PPWR (Reg. (EU) 2025/40):

Papier-Schäfer GmbH & Co. KG acts pursuant to Reg. (EU) 2025/40 as a supplier of packaging materials (Art. 3(1) No. 16 & Art. 16). The producer and distributor obligations for the final packaged product remain with the brand owner / distributor (Art. 3(1) No. 15).

Compliance with Substance Restrictions (Article 5 PPWR, Food Contact & EU Standards):

All labels manufactured by Papier-Schäfer (paper and plastic film laminates, adhesives, printing inks, varnishes & stamping foils) comply with the statutory requirements pursuant to Article 5 of Reg. (EU) 2025/40 as well as applicable EU standards for indirect food contact:

Food Contact & GMP:	Manufactured according to Good Manufacturing Practice (GMP - EC No 2023/2006). Suitable for indirect food contact pursuant to Reg. (EC) No 1935/2004 and Reg. (EU) No 10/2011 (primary aromatic amines below limit of detection).
Bisphenol-Free:	Free from Bisphenol A, B, and S (BPA-free pursuant to Regulation (EU) 2024/3190).
PFAS Compliance:	All constituent components fall below the threshold values for fluorine compounds (< 50 mg/kg Total Fluorine / < 25 ppb single substances)
Heavy Metal Limits:	The sum concentration of lead, cadmium, mercury, and hexavalent chromium is demonstrably below 100 ppm (EU 2025/40 & US CONEG).
REACH Compliance & SoC:	Full compliance with Regulation (EC) No 1907/2006 (REACH). No Candidate List SVHC substances above 0.1 % w/w .
Mineral Oil Free:	All printing inks, varnishes, and self-adhesive materials used are free from mineral oils (MOSH/MOAH-free).
EuPIA & RoHS:	Compliance with the EuPIA Exclusion Policy, the Swiss Ordinance on Materials and Articles (817.023.21), and the RoHS Directive (2011/65/EU).
Recycled Content (PCR):	Standard materials consist of virgin raw material 0 % PCR. Specific recycled papers with up to 100 % PCR content are available upon request.
Recyclability & Material Fraction:	Paper labels are categorized for paper & board recycling streams (DIN EN 643 / ZSVR); plastic film labels (PE/PP/PET) are categorized for plastic recycling streams (DSD / Yellow Sack).
